- How many answers did you change?

Question

VS

Content

- Reading too fast
- Missing key words and/or misreading the question

- Not enough exposure and/or practice with the tested information
- Difficulty applying the material in new ways

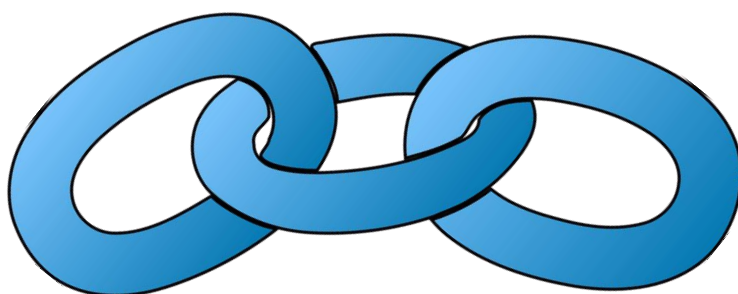
**TRUST
